A reminder that if your child wears a headscarf they should be practical and suitable for PE and playtimes please.

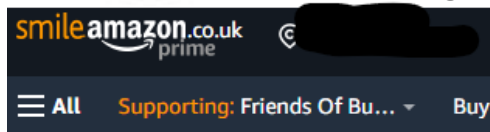

Cross Country

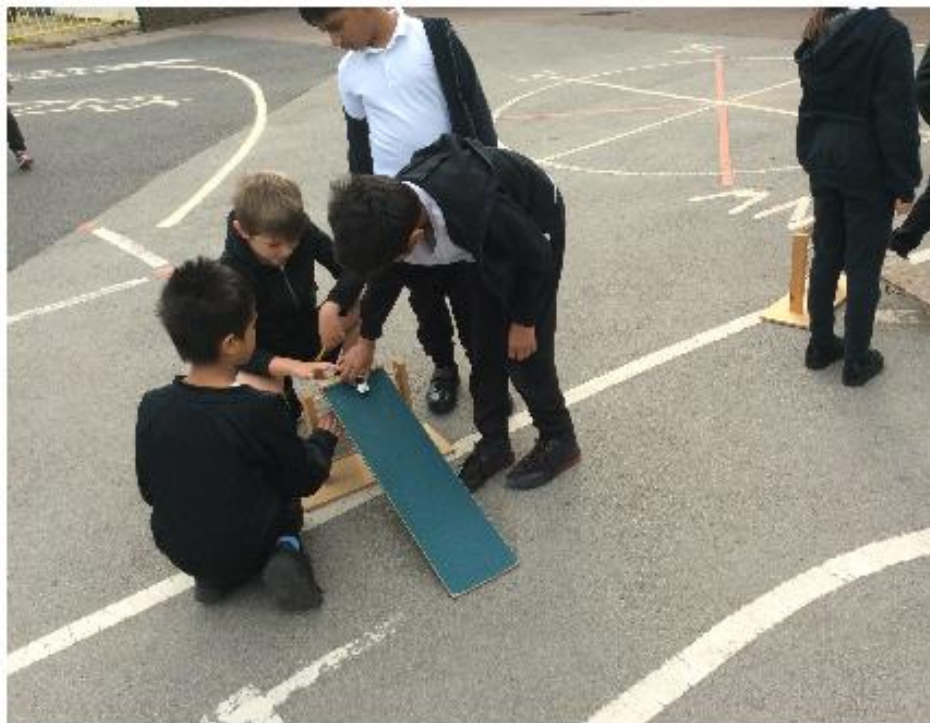
Year 6 Girls Gold and Year 6 Boys silver.

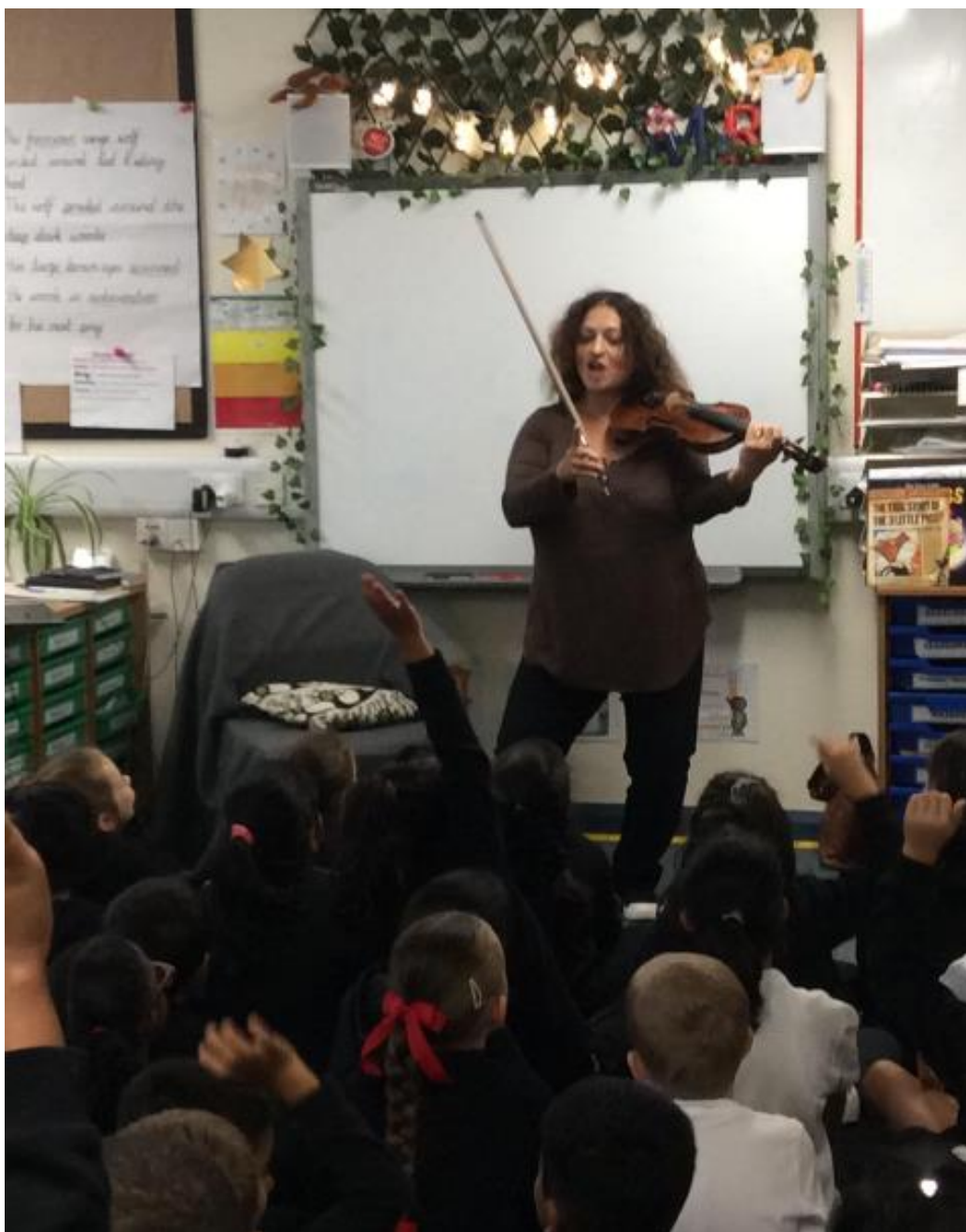


Each day the children in Reception go and play running around games to help them build big muscles. Today, Red Class went to the 'big playground' to use the track for running races. We had lots of fun!
