Year 6 Girls Gold and Year 6 Boys silver.






Each day the children in Reception go and play running around games to help them build big muscles. Today, Red Class went to the 'big playground' to use the track for running races. We had lots of fun!








Year 4 were developing their skill of identifying variables and asking scientific questions.
