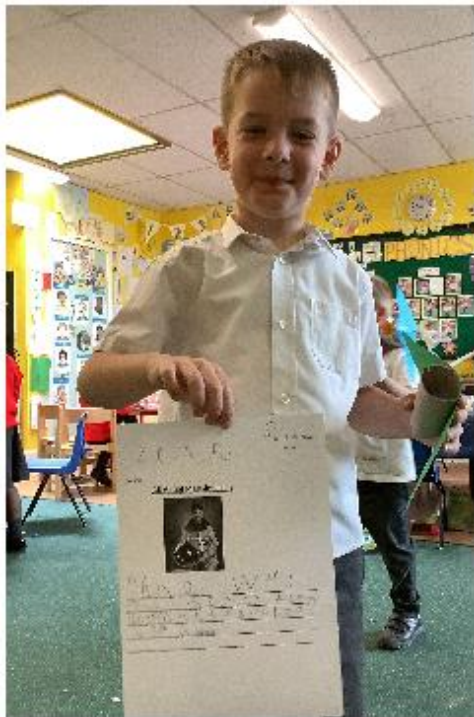
This week we hosted a Luton Primary Games tournament. Thank you to the PE team, Mr Read and Mrs Shaw for their hard work!
