Curriculum Overview

English

- ★ To explore myths and legends from Ancient Greece.
- ★ To identify the features of a Greek Myth.
- ★ To plan and write character descriptions for Percy Jackson and mythical creatures.

Maths

- ★ To add and subtract fractions, including adding and subtracting a fraction from a mixed number.
- ★ Add and subtract two mixed numbers.
- ★ To use written multiplication methods to multiply: 4 digit number by 1 digit number, 2 digit number by 2 digit number, 3 digit number, 4 digit number by 2 digit number.
- ★ Solve multiplication and division word problems.
- ★ To use short division, including calculations with remainders.

Science

- ★ To understand the different properties of materials.
- ★ To learn what is meant by an irreversible change.
- ★ To carry out fair investigations to test properties of materials, including absorbency and strength.

Computing

- ★ To increase understanding of the impact that sharing digital content can have.
- ★ To identify ways to report concerns about content and contact online.
- ★ To recognise acceptable and unacceptable behaviour online.

History

★ To explore the Ancient Greeks. We will be looking at the historical impact the Greeks have had on our modern day society, the origins of the Olympic games, various architecture, how democracy was carried out and how this has impacted today's society and within the society of various city states in Ancient Greece.

Music

- ★ To continue to adopt the correct position when playing the pocket trumpet
- ★ To play the notes C, D, E, F and G
- **★** To understand intervals

PE

- ★ Greek Dance; The Hasapiko is a Greek folk dance children will be in a group creating their own dance steps/movement. Groups perform their Greek dance to class.
- ★ Gymnastics: Working with a partner or small groups to create sequences using floor, mats, Adapting sequences with the use of apparatus. Looking at some elements of gymnastic balance, shapes, rolls, movements/skills, travel, etc
