Opening Times:

The clubs are open to all pupils from R to Year 6 at Bushmead Primary School, on a first come first served basis.

Monday to Friday (term time)

Breakfast Club - 7.45 - 8.40

Twilight Club - 15.30 - 18.00

Transfer between the clubs and school will be safe and supervised. The club is situated in the Lower Hall & Farmer's Kitchen. The library, huts and outdoor spaces will also be accessed. The club is a relaxed environment with plenty of opportunities for play. Children will be able to choose from a variety of activities or to relax in a quiet space. There will also be an opportunity for children to read and complete homework activities.

Breakfast Club

Registration

Anyone using our clubs must be registered to do so. You must ensure that your contact details and medical information are up to date with the school office.

All places must be pre-booked and prepaid.

Days and times must be specified on the registration form. We may not be able to accommodate variations due to availability. Please contact the school office in advance.

How many spaces do we have?

We are able to accommodate 70 children for each club. This is due to staff/child ratios and legal requirements. If you are unable to book a place, that would indicate the clubs are full; therefore, please do not expect your child to attend either club.

Illness and Medical Matters

Children who are ill should not attend our Clubs. If a child becomes unwell during club hours, staff will call parents, so arrangements can be made for the child to be collected. Club staff will be apprised of any medical needs a child has and follow the schools medical policies.

Behaviour & Disciplinary Matters

Any disciplinary matters will be brought to the attention of the parents by the Club Leaders. If there is a persistent issue it will be brought to the attention of the headteacher. The school behaviour policy will be followed.

School Closure

If for any reason there is a school closure we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible. Please also refer to the school website/communication and local radio stations for information. Refunds will be given in this event.

Child Care Vouchers

Child Care vouchers will be accepted towards payment. If you are already using vouchers for Breakfast Club the code will be the same for Twilight Club. How can we make sure our Clubs run smoothly?

- Bookings must be made in advance and payment is required in full monthly.
- We will not allow parents to go into arrears. If you have difficulty paying please contact the school office.
- Please arrive on time to collect your child. Children become very distressed if you are late. Late pick up for the first half of Twilight Club will mean you will be charged for the whole session.
- If lateness is unavoidable then a telephone call is essential and alternative arrangements for collecting your child should be made. Please communicate with us. **Twilight Club (club time only) 07946 005 847**
- If you are after 6pm you will be charged an additional half session. If this continues you may lose your place at the Club. We are obliged under Safeguarding procedures to call Social Services if your child has not been picked up.
- Always make sure we have up to date contact details.
- Inform the club leaders if you have any concerns.
